

2019 White Burgundy (Pinot Blanc)

A full-bodied burgundy from the slate of the Saar? We have struggled for a long time at Van Volxem, to accept a different grape variety other than Riesling. In being the first winery on the Saar to produce White Burgundy, we have created a new interpretation of the wine, yet continued our tradition of wine with moderate alcohol, which is a perfect food companion. Again, and again we are amazed at what happens when old Burgundy vines and perfect climatic conditions meet excellent slate slopes. Tiny little yields of gold-coloured burgundy berries create a full-bodied, silky wine that unfolds on the palate a sea of aromas of ripe exotic fruits, exhilarating spring blossoms and the finest precious wood notes. With its moderate acidity, it is a great wine for all occasions.

Still with yeasty and some oaky notes on the intense yet lime-fresh and flinty nose, the 2018 Weissburgunder is a rich and elegant, pretty lush and mouth-filling Pinot Blanc with intense tropical fruit but crystalline acidity and structure.
