

2019 Wiltinger Riesling

With this wine it is easy to imagine you are biting into the dark brown slate of this region. Firstly a subtle hint of smoky mineral and white pepper reminiscent of slate. After a few minutes in a large glass, this wine shaped from the land develops refined earthy aromas, with delicate nuances of blueberry, juniper and sloe. The Braunfels Riesling, with its aromatic, iodine minerality is one of our best food companions. A noble wine in a noble guise!

The 2018 Wiltinger Riesling offers a clear, spicy and coolish bouquet of weathered, clayey slate and ripe, precise white stone fruit aromas in the background. Lush and intense yet crystalline, crunchy and even salty and piquant on the palate, this is an impressively fruity, silky-textured Wiltinger that reveals a remarkably intense and long finish. An impressive village wine sourced in the Rosembreg and Volz. Highly recommended. Tasted from AP #10 19 in June 2019.

Precise, clear bouquet, with floral, fruity and mineral notes such as acacia flowers and a hint of graphite. The wine is juicy and fine on the palate. The olfactory properties are reproduced perfectly and the minerality also prevails. I notice a slight bitterness at the end of the palate. It has a positive influence on the aromatic expression because it has a supporting effect. Nice tension in the finish. 2020-2032 **90/10**
